Pastoral Ministry

Executive Pastor/Senior Pastor: Grace Baptist Church, a one-hundred year old, stagnated wanting to grow church of 700 weekly attendance located in the western New Jersey Sky country -- January 2003 to December 2005 (One year into my ministry at Grace the Senior Pastor resigned to accept the call of another church. At that time I became the de-facto Senior Pastor pending a formal search process.)

Responsibilities: To oversee staff and the ministry areas of Grace, to provide operational leadership, to focus on high level issues that need to be addressed day-to-day, to provide both leadership and management expertise to drive issues and opportunities forward, and to oversee the alignment of tea energies toward the fulfillment of the vision of the church.

Associate Pastor: Four Mile Presbyterian Church, a two-hundred year old, traditional wanting to become seeker-sensitive church of 400 weekly attendance located in the western Pittsburgh suburbs whose mission is to be the church -- May 2001 to November 2002

Responsibilities: Direction of adult ministries, assistance in the pastoral care of the congregation, and creation of a small group ministry to move the church toward a "church of small groups."

Assistant Pastor: Orchard Hill Church, a contemporary, non-denominational, seeker-oriented church of 1800 weekly attendance located in the northern Pittsburgh suburbs whose mission is to reach seekers and build believers -- January 1998 to May 2001

Responsibilities: Pastoral care and counseling, education, and direction of the small group ministry
